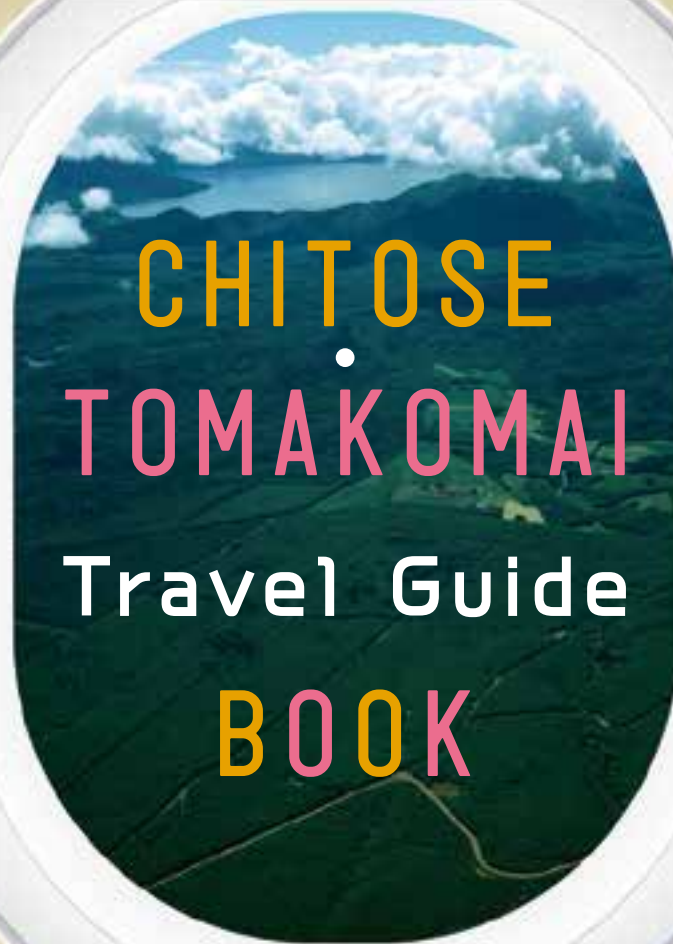

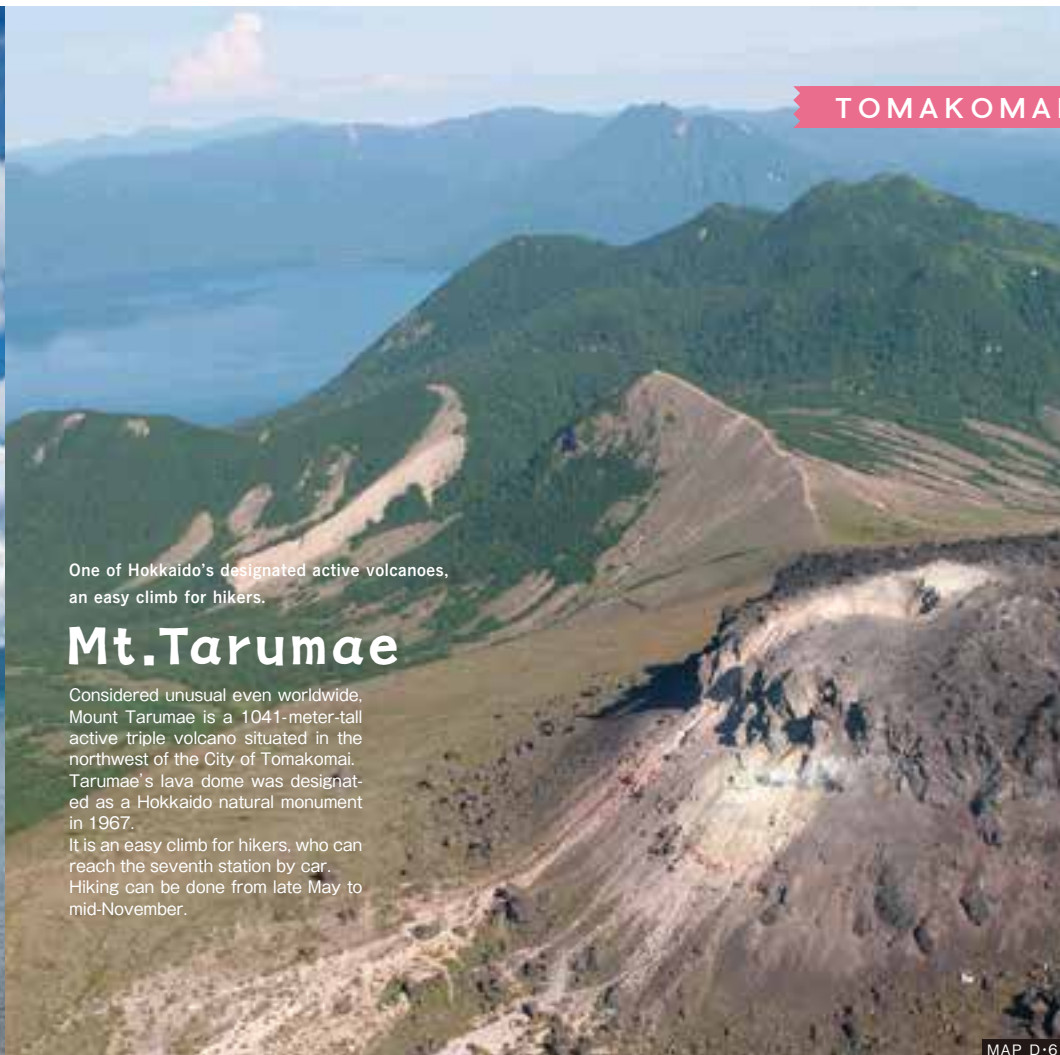


Lake Shikotsu is a kind of "mystic lake."
Its water quality is the best among all the lakes in Japan.

Lake Shikotsu

One of the biggest caldera lakes formed approx. 40 thousand years ago, and the northernmost ice-free lake in Japan, even during the severe winter. It is encircled by the towering Mount Eniwa, Mount Tarumae, and others like them. Surrounded by pristine forest, the mystic image of Lake Shikotsu is a prominent feature of the wild landscape of the Chitose area. Lake Shikotsu was selected for best water quality by a survey of the Ministry of the Environment.

Mt. Tarumae

Considered unusual even worldwide, Mount Tarumae is a 1041-meter-tall active triple volcano situated in the northwest of the City of Tomakomai. Tarumae's lava dome was designated as a Hokkaido natural monument in 1967. It is an easy climb for hikers, who can reach the seventh station by car. Hiking can be done from late May to mid-November.

Lake Shikotsu Kokanee salmon

The kokanee salmon caught in Lake Shikotsu is a land-locked red salmon called "Chip." They live out their entire lives in freshwater rivers and lakes. The flesh of the fish has a light pink color. Enjoy the native kokanee salmon during the fishing season from June 1st to August 31st. Out of the fishing season, you can also enjoy frozen kokanee salmon, which becomes even tastier.

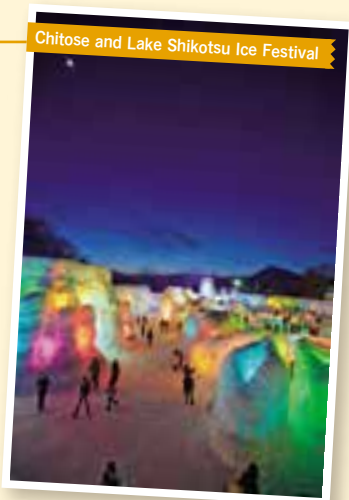
A hidden gem of Mother Nature,

Lake Utonai is a Designated National Wildlife Protection Area and a Ramsar Site. Utonai's roadside station is situated by the National Highway Route 36, a main artery of travel around central Hokkaido. It's close to New Chitose Airport and Tomakomai Ferry Terminal, too. There are local food shops with surf clams and Tomakomai-grown brand-name pork, and restaurants and shops offering a variety of seafood and mountain products that showcase the area's charm.
