Special Cash Payment

Those who are registered in the Basic Resident Registration System as of 27 April 2020 are eligible to receive the 100,000 yen per person benefit. It will be directly transferred into the bank account for each household. Foreigners on short stays are not eligible.

How can I apply?

The municipalities will send an application form by mail. Please apply within three months of the date of the start of applications. If you have moved, it is possible that you may not receive the application form. If this is the case, please contact to the municipality you lived in before moving.

Temporary Loan Emergency Funds

The Social Welfare Councils of all prefectures have in place a welfare fund loan system that lends necessary funds for living and other expenses to low-income households.

In light of the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, the number of households that are eligible for loans under this system will be expanded to include non-low-income households.

Housing Security Benefit

If you are at risk of losing your place to live due to a decrease in income or loss of work, you may be eligible for this subsidy.

The municipal government will subsidize your rent (via direct payment to the landlord) for, in general, 3 months, with a set maximum of 9 months.
